HOW TO MAKE A STICK HORSE

Making a stick horse is EASY and fun!

Schedule a Team meeting to prep for the rally and make your horse.

1. Start with a broomstick (or any stick without sharp edges or splinters) big enough for you to “ride” safely. You can get wooden dowels from Home Depot or any building supply store.
2. Get a men’s sock (white is easier to draw on) and fill it with newspaper, from toe to top, so that it has an “L” shape.
3. Push the stick up into the heel of the stuffed sock, and tie/staple/tape the sock opening to the stick.
4. Add eyes (glue fake eyes or use felt or buttons or draw them), ears, mane, tail (ribbon or yarn for mane, tail and forlock), tack, spots as you wish.

Be Wild or Mild. Voila, you have a mount worthy to bring to the E.B.T.H.* STICK HORSE RALLY!
