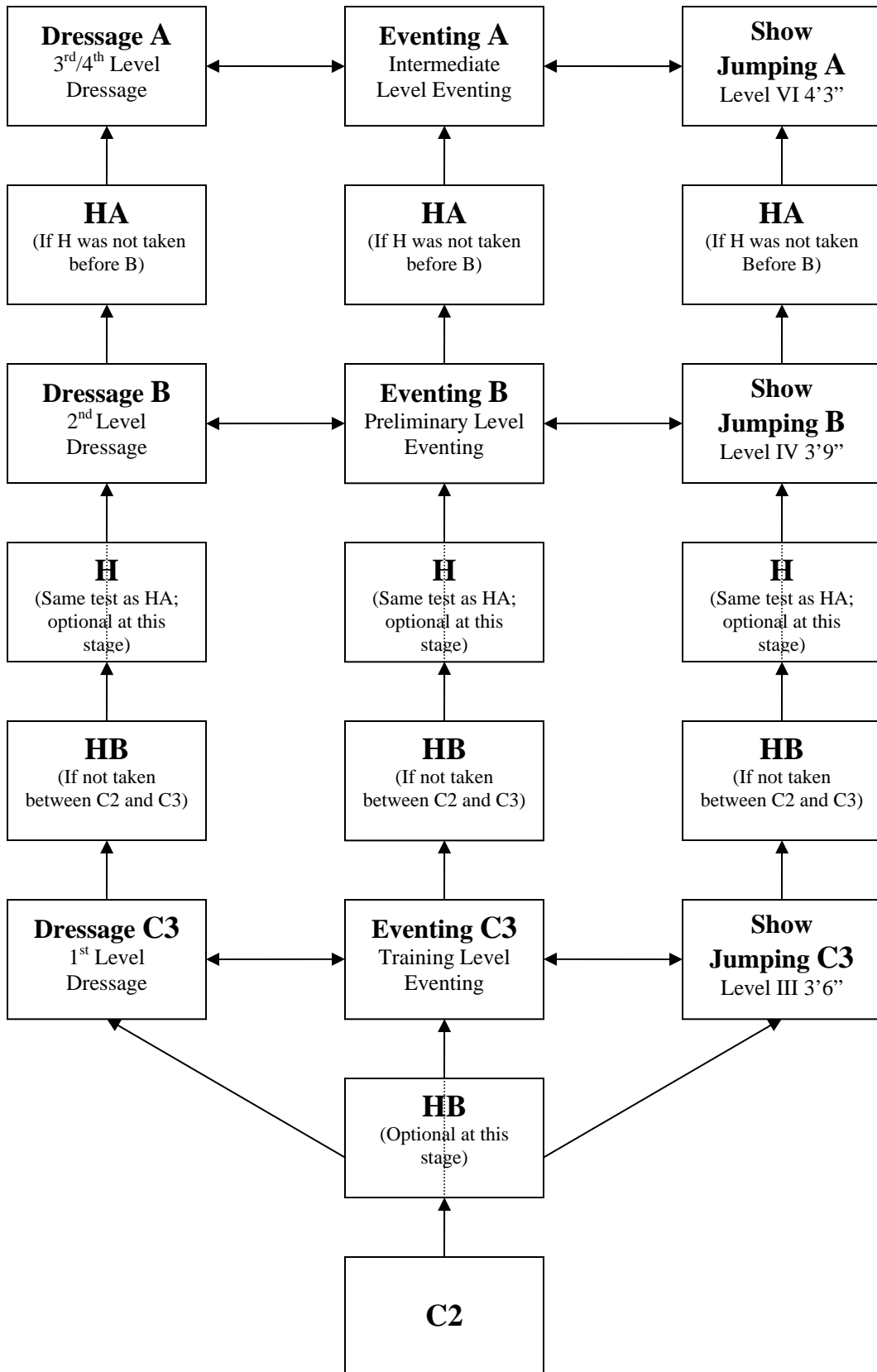


Specialty Ratings Navigation Chart



Specialty Ratings Navigation Chart

Notes:

- The Specialty Ratings and HB Rating will take effect on August 1, 2007.
- Please note the following age requirements:
 - HB: 13 years old as of January 1 in the year of taking the rating
 - B: 14 years old as of January 1 in the year of taking the rating
 - H and HA: 16 years old as of January 1 in the year of taking the rating
- A member completing a C3 riding test before passing the HB is called a C+ until the HB is passed.
- Members who choose to take their HA rating before their B rating will be awarded the H rating designation.
- There will no longer be a waiting requirement between the upper level ratings, so C3 and B could be taken back to back in the same weekend.
- Members already at the C3 level or above on August 1, 2007, start in the chart at the box for their current rating in the Eventing track.
- Members can also move laterally between Dressage and Show Jumping within any level (not shown on the chart).
- The arrows indicate the directions of movement that are allowed, if there is no arrow, that direction is not allowed.
- Here are some rules to help you remember how it works:
 - Straight upward movement is allowed (i.e. Traditional C-3 to Traditional B).
 - Diagonal movement upwards is not allowed (i.e. Traditional C-3 to Show Jumping B is not allowed).
 - Lateral movement is required before moving upwards in a different track (i.e. Traditional C-3 to Dressage C-3 before Dressage B).
 - Diagonal movement downwards (not shown on the chart) is allowed but not required (i.e. Traditional B to Show Jumping C-3 is okay but not required).

...and yes, members can take their C3, B and A in all three disciplines!
